# **Action Taken report/outcomes**

- Keeping in view, the interest of the students, the Dean-Students Welfare has been established in the college.
- The agenda, minutes and necessary actions taken in the meetings were documented and digitally processed in retrievable format, proper recording and geo-tagging of the meetings has also been done.
- IQAC facilitated timely promotion of teachers to higher grades. In this session six faculty members got their promotion.
- IQAC and Dean Students Welfare jointly organized an Orientation Program for the newly admitted students (16 18 Nov. 2021).
- Department of Botany and IQAC jointly organized a program on "Seedling Management of Medicinal Plants" and distribution of Harsringar Plants (01 Oct. 2021).
- Successfully conducted seven days workshop on e-content for non-teaching staff (5 11 Oct. 2021).
- IQAC successfully organized a one-day Orientation Programme cum Workshop on 10 Dec. 2021 on Job Placement.
- Department of Bio-Informatics organized a Motivational cum Interactive Lecture for the college students under the guidance of IQAC (18 Dec. 2021).
- The college has successfully organized the Ch Charan Singh Inter Collegiate Men's Kabaddi Tournament (19 20 Dec. 2021) and "69<sup>th</sup> Annual Sports" of the college (22 23 Feb. 2022).
- Various training programmes/workshops were organized for the teachers by IQAC of the college.
  - A training drive was conducted on e-Content development for faculties (21 22 Oct. 2021 and 22 Nov. 2021).

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- First workshop was organized on Intellectual Property Rights (26 Apr. 2022).
- ➤ A seven-day Faculty Training Program on e-Content Development was organized for the teachers (23 - 31 May 2022).
- In joint partnership of IQAC and Department of Genetics & Plant Breeding (G&PB), Department of Agronomy, Department of Botany organized educational tours for students.
- College's Career Guidance and the Placement Cell under the aegis of IQAC has organized placement programs. The companies viz MKD Crop Science Pvt. Limited, Tetrahedron Manufacturing Services Private Limited and Sahib Pesticides visited the campus and recruited 14 students.
- To develop Entrepreneurship among students a Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between Janta Vedic College Baraut and Unnat Kisan Bio Energy Farmer Producer Company. Company will provide resources to motivate students for self-employment. Another MoU has been signed between Janta Vedic College Baraut and NBPGR, Pusa, New Delhi (An ICAR institution) for facilitating students' training / postgraduate research work.
- Free coaching classes have been started in the college for students preparing the competitive exams such as UPSC, Bank PO, Police Recruitment, ASIB examination etc.
- Under the aegis of IQAC, the village Chhachharpur has been adopted for Social Development through NSS and Other Extension Activities.
- Six courses for Skill Development Programs prepared by the Faculty of the College were sent to the Ch. Charan Singh University Meerut for approval.
- In the year 2021-22, twenty-three college teachers have participated in programmes such as Faculty Development Programme, Orientation Course, Refresher Course, workshop *etc.* Faculties of the college also published 15 books/book chapters and 55 research papers (out of which 08 papers are in SCOPUS indexed journals).
- The college through its NSS/NCC/Cultural Committee has organized various types of extension and outreach programs such as environmental protection, road safety, cleanliness campaign, Mission Shakti, Beti Bachao and Beti Padhao.
- Proper Feedback System became operational in the college.
