Introduction

Janta Vedic College has initiated the implementation of its Institutional Development Plan (IDP) 2025–2040 in alignment with NEP 2020, NAAC guidelines, and SDG-4. The plan focuses on academic excellence, infrastructure development, digital transformation, research promotion, and student-centric growth.

Progress Report till 31st March 26

1. Academic and Quality Enhancement

- New initiatives include introduction of B.Sc. Home Science and an additional section in B.Sc. Agriculture under self-finance mode to meet increasing student demand and promote career-oriented education
- The college has significantly enhanced the use of ICT-enabled teaching-learning practices. Platforms such as Google Classroom have been widely adopted across departments to facilitate online classes, assignment submission, and continuous student engagement. The implementation and usage details of these ICT tools have been systematically documented and will be reflected in the PRAMAN portal, ensuring transparency and effective monitoring of digital teaching practices.
- The college has taken significant steps towards digital transformation and quality enhancement. The institution has completed its registration on the I-STEM portal, and faculty members have also been registered to promote research, innovation, and access to advanced facilities.
- The library has been strengthened through the procurement of DELNET (Developing Library Network) subscription, enhancing access to e-resources and research materials. To ensure academic integrity, DrillBit plagiarism detection software has been procured and implemented. Moreover, the institution has adopted the “One Nation One Subscription” initiative to provide wider access to national-level academic resources and databases.
- Further, the institution has applied for ISO certification from the Government of India, reflecting its commitment to quality standards in academic and administrative processes.
- The admission and promotion processes are being carried out through the Samarth Portal, ensuring transparency and efficiency in student management.
- The registration process for the Alumni Association has been initiated to strengthen alumni engagement and institutional support.

- The college has also signed several Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with academic and industry partners to enhance collaboration, training, and placement opportunities.
- Expansion of library resources.
- Active functioning of IQAC.
