MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on **14.08.2026**, between the Faculty of Agricultural Science, Mahaveer University, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh and the Faculty of Agriculture, Janta Vedic College, Baraut, Baghpat Uttar Pradesh. Both parties, hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Parties," agree to collaborate for the purpose of advancing agricultural education, research, and extension activities of mutual benefit.

1. OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of this MOU is to establish a framework for academic and research cooperation between the two institutions, with a view to promoting excellence in agricultural education, facilitating faculty and student exchange, fostering joint research initiatives, and contributing to the advancement of knowledge in agriculture and allied sciences.

2. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The Parties agree to collaborate in, but not limited to, the following areas:

- Joint organization of seminars, workshops, conferences, and training programmes in agriculture and allied disciplines.
- Exchange of faculty members and research scholars for lectures, collaborative research, and academic visits.
- Student exchange programmes, internships, and Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) sharing.



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- d) Joint research projects, publications, and grant applications at national and international levels.
- e) Sharing of library resources, e-journals, databases, and academic materials.
- f) Development of joint curricula, academic programmes, and online courses in agriculture.
- g) Technology transfer and consultancy services to the farming community.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTY A (MAHAVEER UNIVERSITY)

Mahaveer University shall:

- a) Designate a nodal officer/coordinator for implementation of this MOU.
- b) Provide access to its instructional farm, laboratories, and facilities to visiting scholars/students from Party B subject to institutional norms.
- c) Share relevant academic resources including curriculum, syllabi, and study materials.
- d) Facilitate participation of its faculty and students in joint activities organized under this MOU.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTY B (JANTA VEDIC COLLEGE)

Janta Vedic College shall:

- a) Designate a nodal officer/coordinator for implementation of this MOU.
- b) Provide access to its facilities, laboratories, and resources to visiting scholars/students from Party A subject to institutional norms.
- c) Share relevant academic resources including curriculum, syllabi, and study materials.
- d) Facilitate participation of its faculty and students in joint activities organized under this MOU.

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Unless mutually agreed otherwise in writing, each party shall bear its own costs related to activities conducted under this MOU, including travel, accommodation, and other incidental expenses. Specific collaborative projects requiring pooled funding shall be governed by separate agreements detailing the financial obligations of each party.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

All intellectual property, including but not limited to inventions, publications, data, and software, developed jointly under this MOU shall be mutually owned by both Parties in equal proportion, unless otherwise agreed in writing. Each party retains ownership of intellectual property developed independently prior to or outside the scope of this MOU.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY

Both Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary information shared during the course of collaboration and shall not disclose such information to any third party without prior written consent of the disclosing party. This obligation shall survive the termination of this MOU for a period of three (3) years.

8. DURATION AND RENEWAL

This MOU shall be valid for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing by both Parties. It may be renewed by mutual written consent of both Parties. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving three (3) months' written notice to the other Party.



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9. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall first be resolved amicably through mutual discussions between the designated representatives of both Parties. If the dispute cannot be resolved amicably within thirty (30) days, it shall be referred to an arbitrator mutually appointed by both Parties, and the proceedings shall be governed by the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (India).

10. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- This MOU does not create any legal obligation for either party to enter into a formal contract.
- This MOU shall not be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture, or agency between the Parties.
- Any amendment to this MOU shall be made only with the written consent of both Parties.
- This MOU shall be governed by the laws of India.

The President of India (herein after called the second Party) of the second part which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include his successors in office and assigns.

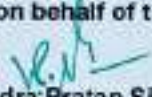

5. In case any dispute arises, the redressal system mentioned in the MOU will be invoked.

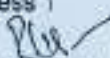

जबकि:

- यह कॉलेज कृषि और उसमें जुड़े विषयों की शिक्षा देने वाला एक प्रमुख संस्थान है इसका उद्देश्य अपने स्टूडेंट्स को प्रैक्टिकल ट्रेनिंग और इंडस्ट्री में अनुभव देना है।
- यह एनजीओ एक रजिस्टर्ड गैर-सरकारी, नॉट-फॉर-प्रॉफिट संगठन है जो बागपत और उत्तर प्रदेश क्षेत्र में कृषि छात्रों और कृषि और संबद्ध क्षेत्र के किसानों के लिए कौशल विकास और उद्यमिता प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रमों के लिए काम करता है।

6. समाप्ति
