- Encouraging and facilitating the teachers for workshops/orientation/refresher/training programs on different aspects of research from reputed institutes/societies/NGOs.



Action taken report/ outcomes


- Admission program, different examinations and evaluations such as internal and external were conducted and completed as per the academic calendar and followed the directions from the CCS University Meerut from time to time.
