Submission of Manuscript :

(i) The manuscript must be neatly and flawlessly typed double space and sent through e-mail to save time and postage.

(ii) Research papers based in Lab./Farm works should give the address of the Lab./Institute/Farm where the work was conducted indicating the period of conducting the experiments.

(iii) Adequate margins should be left to allow editor's Reviewer remarks.

(iv) All the pages should be numbered consecutively.

(v) The first submission should be made in hardcopy in triplicate along with a forwarding letter/Article certificate.

(vi) C.D. should not be sent on first submission of the article. Only the revised and final version of accepted articles should be sent in C.D. or through e-mail.

(vii) In the final version Tables and Illustrations should be placed as close as possible to the parts of the text to which they relate.

Contributions, it is regretted, will on no account be returned. So the authors should preserve a copy of their articles before submission. Routine papers theoretical in nature and of no consequence, having no novelty and further use, relating to investigation in a narrow specialized branch of discipline or of local importance and based on old data will be summarily rejected. Papers adding new knowledge and fresh perspective, showing lacunae in present research and suggesting possible lines of future work will be preferred.
