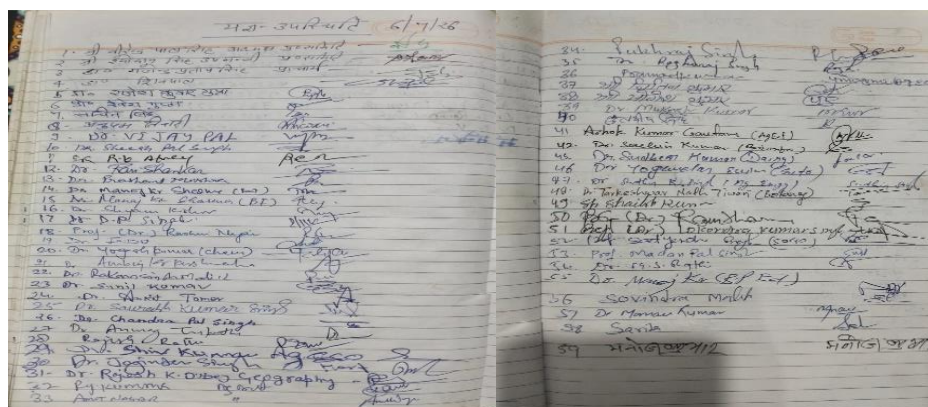


Outcome Indicators of Best Practices (2026–27)

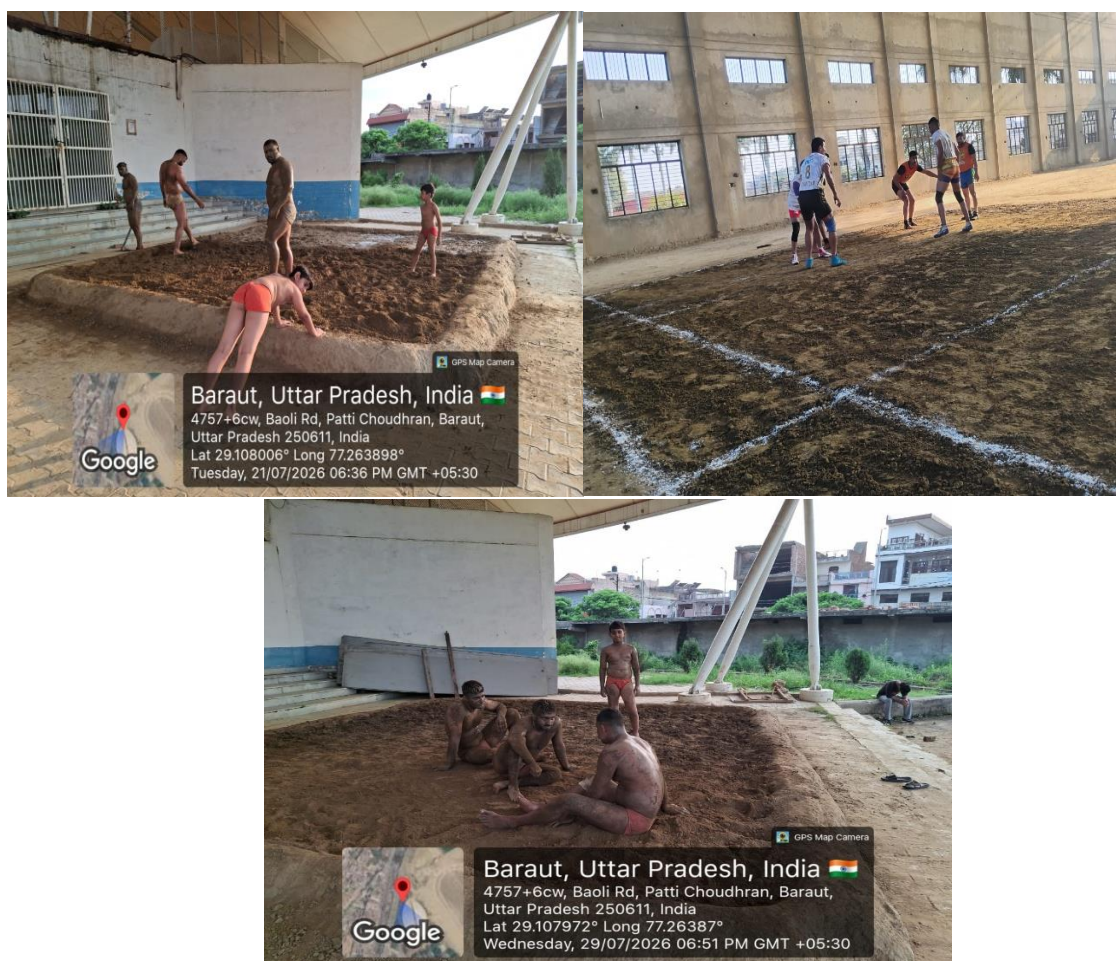
